


Sennybridge to Aberbran

Length: 8.25 km 5.1 miles Time 1 – 3 hours

Hassle free canoeing: 18th October and 2nd March inclusive. In the event of high water outside this period, additional access is 'granted' when the water height on the [gauge](#) at Brecon is above the red marker.

Directions:

From Brecon take the A40 west towards Llandovery for 8.5 miles to Sennybridge. Drive through the village and take the lane on your right just in front of the Red Lion pub. If you have a trailer, please beware of any vehicles parked near to the turning. Follow the lane down to the river, and round to the right (where it turns into a track). Travel along the track until you come to the wide open space that is the farmers' market car park. Please do not park in the red lion's car park.

Parking:

Canoeist access to the river is in the left hand corner of the farmers' market car park. Please remember that this is only a drop-off point. Those who require long term parking should use the public car park in the centre of Sennybridge above the Usk & Railway Hotel. (**We've always left vehicles in the field.**)



Accessing the water: Via the path down to the river in the north western corner of the farmers' market car park.

Aberbran Egress

Directions: From Sennybridge take the A40 east towards Brecon. After 4.6 miles take a left turn opposite a lay-by towards Aberbran. Drive over the Usk taking the next turning left down the track in front of the farm buildings.

Loading and Parking: Pull off this track on the building side to load or unload. Do not unload anywhere on the road as it is surprisingly busy and traffic jams will occur. For those needing parking, the landowner has kindly agreed to allow vehicles to be left in the farm yard. Please note, however, that only 5 vehicles are permitted at a time. Last time we parked in the caravan area just beyond farm yard (near the word 'track' on map, Steve W sorted it with owner) Please use the lay-by on the A40 as alternative parking if the yard is full.

Carry boats through the field from the water's edge just upstream of the bridge. Do not drive through the field to the river.



0.5km bridge
1 km 1st drop Centre or RR

1.3 km 2nd drop Centre or RR

2km 3rd drop RL if low or RR but look out for tree lodged 2009-12

3.6 km bridge (good alternative get out next to large red arrow on map below)

5.75 km bridge (shortly followed by small footbridge)

6.4 km bridge nice house RR

8.25 km Egress on the beach river left- just before the bridge,
